President's Report: Gina Stover

2024-2025 Agenda Book discussion

Costs for these books have significantly gone up over the years. They started at \$2160 in 2021, went up to \$2362 in 2022, \$2475 in 2023, expected 2024 costs to exceed \$2600.

In addition to Dr. Berical surveying the teachers, Gina polled Skyview Parents on Facebook and said the majority of respondents reported they did not use the agenda books. Michele Ferrante asked why this expense comes out of a home and school budget. Other meeting participants responded that they think it's a team/ teacher preference on whether they encourage students to use these and the books should only be ordered for those teams.

Dr. Berical said having the school pay for these can be explored but the expense has not been allocated in her budget for next year so if Home and School doesn't pay for them, she's not sure if they'll be able to pay for them. Lauren Pires recommended having it sourced as a mini grant request from the teachers who want them. Dr. Berical will have teachers put in their requests before Memorial Day and Dr. Berical will submit the mini grant request on their behalf. Invoice will be paid after July 1 from the 2024-25 home and school budget.

Bus Driver Appreciation Breakfast – Gina requested the Skyview budget for this event be increased from \$75 to \$125 due to rising costs. Michele motioned, Agata seconded.
