Banking:

- -Starting the year with around \$17,000, which is comparable to last September, and puts us in a good place moving into this year
- -Money has been moved to Ambler Savings Bank per MCC vote last September

Income:

- -Almost \$1,700 deposited to the bank this summer from various sources all outstanding from last year
 - -Company matches from the MCC totaled \$710
 - -\$800 in Venmo account from extra yearbook sales
 - -\$180 was still in the Givebutter account from Pinball
- -\$24 in Spirit Wear sales at Popsicles with the Principal
- -Just received check back from Lifetouch from \$1323.62

Spending:

- -1 outstanding Fun Day reimbursement (\$150)
 - -replacing broken tablet on photo booth
- -Konstella subscription for the year (\$350)
