Personnel Update:

A new Principal, Michael Bourdreau, was approved at Arcola, with Dr. Amy Mangano beginning a new position as a Supervisor of Special Education. Dr. Mangano will continue to be acting Principal at Arcola until Mr. Bourdreau is able to transition to Methacton, which could take up to 60 days.

Joyce Amici was approved as interim Principal of Worcester Elementary, effective August 1, 2021.
