

F. SCOTT FITZGERALD was born in St. Paul Minnesota, in 1896 and attended Princeton University. He was a major new literary voice whose novels "This Side of Paradise," "The Beautiful and Damned," "The Great Gatsby," and "Tender is the Night" - made him one of the most famous writers of his time. He died of a heart attack in 1940 at the age of forty-four. For his sharp social insights and pitchperfect lyricism, Fitzgerald stands out as one of the most important American writers of the twentieth century.

Simon Levy is the Producing Director for the Fountain Theatre in Los Angeles where he's been a resident playwright, director, and producer since 1993. His stage adaptation of THE GREAT GATSBY, a Finalist for the PEN Literary Award in Drama, completes his Fitzgerald Trilogy, which includes TENDER IS THE NIGHT, Winner of the PEN Literary Award in Drama, and THE LAST TYCOON, winner of numerous awards and nominated for the prestigious Los Angeles Drama Critics Circle Ted Schmitt Award for Original Play. He recently completed a new adaptation/ translation of Ibsen's AN ENEMY OF THE PEOPLE: A NEW VERSION FOR THE 21ST CENTURY. He's writing a new play, THE CANARY, as well as a young adult novel based on the story of Tristan and Iseult. His stage adaptation of Eliot Weinberger's celebrated article, WHAT I HEARD ABOUT IRAQ, was produced worldwide, including the Edinburgh Fringe Festival where it won the Fringe First Award, the Adelaide Fringe Festival where it won the Fringe Award, was produced by BBC Radio, and received a 30-city UK tour culminating in London. His directing, writing, and producing credits and awards are numerous. He was recently honored with the Los Angeles Drama Critics Circle Milton Katselas Lifetime Achievement Award in Directing. 

The Great Gatsby - Director's Notes

Like many, my first experience with The Great Gatsby was in high school. Over the years that have passed since then, it always held a fond spot in my memory, symbolizing the glory and glitz of the Jazz Age and the Roaring 20s. However, when I first started thinking about directing Gatsby, I reread the novel and was surprised at how many of the darker aspects I had apparently glossed over in my younger years. After several more readings of both the novel and the adaptation we are using by Simon Levy, I knew this was a show we had to stage. The nuances of the characters, the tragic stories they unfold, and the way it is juxtapositioned against the glamour of what we think of as the Jazz Age made this something I knew our students could give a breath of gorgeous life to.

One of the more difficult aspects of rehearsing Gatsby was bringing to life the sensitive yet important issues that the story encompasses. Asking some of the kindest and most caring humans I have met to portray racist, abusive, and murderous individuals was a challenge. However, I have truly enjoyed the conversations we have been able to have about using our voices as artists and making sure we support organizations fighting the causes of some of these more serious topics. As such, you may have noticed a donation jar in the lobby. We will collect all funds raised through this jar and split them between the Greater Norristown NAACP, Laurel House, and Montgomery County Suicide Prevention Task Force. You can find more information about these organizations from their respective websites, which are located in our program.

Our students have worked diligently to portray these emotional and significant issues in respectful and responsible ways. What you see before you is the culmination of 2 months of long, hard work, by over 65 students, both on and off stage. I could not be more proud of the effort they have all put in and the dedication they have shown to bring you this incredible production.

Thank you for coming to support our students and the beautiful work of art they have created.






