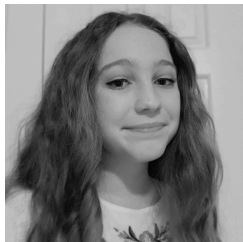

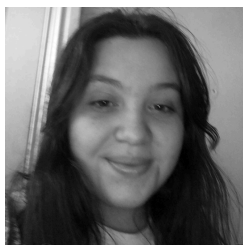

as Mrs. Millennium

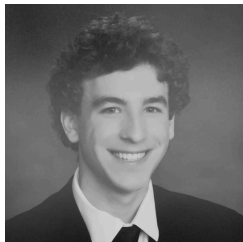

as Billy Boy Bill

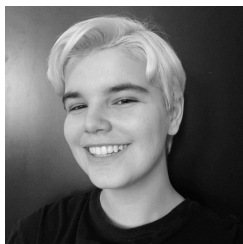

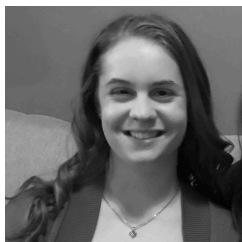

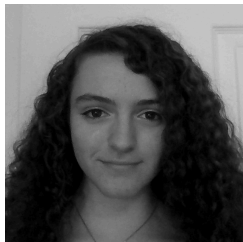


Mimi Cavallo

Staff Ensemble, Cop*

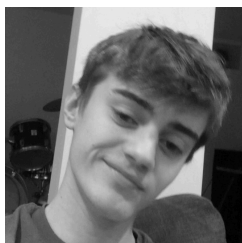

as Penelope Pennywise

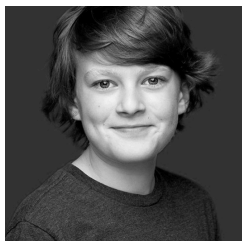

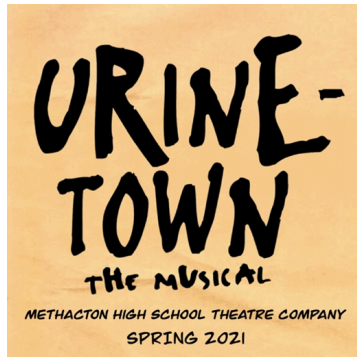

DIRECTOR'S NOTES

Directing this production of Urinetown, the Musical, has been like no other experience I could have ever dreamed up. When we first started planning a Spring Musical, we weren't even sure if or how often we would get to rehearse in person together. We auditioned fully virtually, started rehearsals with a mix of in person and virtual students, and had a Zoom link available for every rehearsal right up until the bitter end, which almost always had at least one person on it.
