

Physical Health in Kindergarten

- Children ages 5-18 should get 60 minutes of moderate to vigorous exercise a day (WHO, 2020)
 - Benefits of children who exercise regularly: healthier lifestyles, gross and motor development, higher cognitive achievement, better social skills
 - LEARNING THROUGH PLAY

Half Day Offers:

- PE: 30 minutes once a week
 - Recess: 15 minutes a day
