Equity

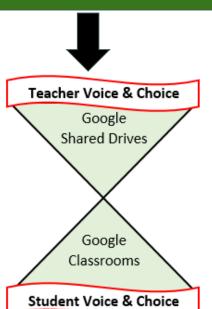
- Collaborative planning across grade levels/subject areas

Expectations for Teachers & Students



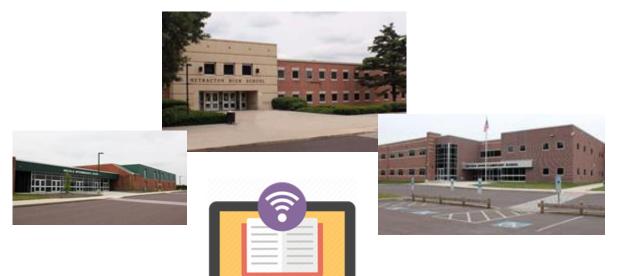
The work & structure represent a new beginning for teachers, administrators, students & parents

- Teachers
 - Collaboration across grade levels/teams/subject areas
 - Focus on essential standards/skills
 - Contribute content/resources based on standards/skills
 - Flexibility in teachers' selection for instruction & resources (Voice & Choice)
- Students
 - Sign in for daily attendance
 - Complete assignments
 - Check on optional assignments as needed
 - Provided with work for up to 10 hours/week (K-4) & up to 15 hours/week (5-12)
 - Flexibility in completing projects & assignments (Voice & Choice)

Collaborative Effort

- Classroom teachers- Regular Education & Special Education
- Gifted-Supporting planning in Google Drives to ensure enrichment activities are available for to add to their Google Classrooms
- ELD Teachers, Reading and Math Specialists-Supporting planning in Google Drives to ensure enrichment & remediation activities are available for teachers to add to their Google Classrooms
- Related Services Staff & 3rd Party Providers- Providing services to students via teletherapy sessions
- Counselors-Contacting families who have not engaged or reached out for assistance; investigating resources for social and emotional supports
- Nurses-Daily office hours to support families; completing paperwork related to screenings, enrollments, and transfers; medication returns; immunizations
- PCAs- Supporting their students via phone calls and Zoom sessions to support their Google Classroom work as well as to provide social and emotional support
- IAs- Supporting instruction for students at the direction of their associated teacher
- Bus Aides/Recess Aides-Completing online trainings

Professional Development



- All completed mandated trainings
- Moved to Google Classroom, Zoom and related resource trainings
- Central office and building administrators meet with planning groups to provide supports and guidance
- Pop-up PD Sessions-As we identify areas of support needed, our tech integrators and administrators create optional sessions for staff to join. Examples include- Cleaning Up Your Google Classroom and Virtual Field Trips through Discovery Education
- In-service Days- Our April in-services (MHS and Elementary) have been rescheduled for June 2. MHS staff will focus on wrapping up the year and planning for adjustments to courses for 20-21; Elementary will focus on Standards Based Grading
